BULLET POINT SYNOPSIS

- 40' Container arrives to make a delivery to a tenant of Mr Ronny Meah, parking in the lane outside. The tenants M & Y aren't present. Ronny Meah gives the driver S a cup of tea. Time Approximately 1510.
- M & Y arrive to unload the container. Weather is sunny, road is dry, visibility is excellent.
- Mr Ronny Meah assists in unloading lorry wearing his Fox 121 Security Ltd high visibility waistcoat.
- Mr Ronny Meah notices a red van known to belong to Mr M Senior, at corner of lane approximately 45 seconds away. Approximately 1545.
- Mr Ronny Meah makes Y, M & S aware of approaching vehicle.
- Mr Ronny Meah glances left to check on vans location, recognises Mr M Senior crouched over the steering wheel as eye contact is made Mr Ronny Meah hears the engine revs increase dramatically and the van accelerates towards Mr Ronny Meah, with Kelly one of his two Jack Russell Terriers stood beside him.
- Mr Ronny Meah freezes momentarily, realising that this is Mr M Senior's third attempt to kill him.
- Mr Ronny Meah leaps back onto the grass verge, staying on his feet.
- There is a screech of brakes and Ronny Meah looks to his right, sees Kelly laying on the road writhing in agony Mr M Senior stops the vehicle and looks through the rear windows of the van making eye contact with Mr Ronny Meah.
- Mr Ronny Meah looks at Mr M Senior and points at Kelly laying in the road and yells "Stop! You killed my dog!" There's no attempt at aggression or aggressive behaviour at this point.
- Y,M and S look on in stunned disbelief and horror.
- Mr Ronny Meah looks at Kelly again & Mr M Senior drives off at speed.
- Mr Ronny Meah picks up Kelly places her on the grass verge, cradling her as she dies (approximately 45

seconds) & asks Y, M & S "Did you get a good look at the driver?" and they confirmed "It was an old boy. "

- Mr Ronny Meah walks away in a daze to compose himself.
- Mr Ronny Meah considers his next move regarding contacting the police taking into account both Mr M Senior & Mr M Junior previous attempt to stab him and to run him over in the lane [supplementary notes]. He also considers the previous history with Essex Police [see Ronny Meah's Personal History Letter].
- Mr Ronny Meah phones Chelmsford Police (not 999) to inform them of what's happened. He is put through to Brentwood Police & makes his report.
- He is told someone will be sent subject to availability.
- Conversation happens between Mr Ronny Meah, Y, M & S in which latter three agree & declare "he could have murdered you. "
- Approximately 1615 Mr M Junior (MJ) drives to Mr Ronny Meah's property in a Black Mercedes. A short conversation occurs.
- MJ: "Is the dog okay?"
- RM: "Does it look like it's okay? The dog is dead. "
- MJ: "I didn't mean to kill the dog. "
- RM: "You weren't the driver. "
- Y, M & S look at Mr Ronny Meah, confer and agree that it wasn't him driving.
- RM asks Mr M Junior "What are you going to do next? Stab me?"
- MJ: To the effect "I killed your dog I should call the police. " before leaving.
- The police arrive. PC W & PC L.
- PC W asks Mr Ronny Meah for an explanation of events.
- PC L interrupts saying "Move your dog as it's offensive. "
- RM: "Can I have a moment please I'm in shock. "
- PC L: "If you don't I'll arrest you for health & hygiene it's attracting flies. "
- RM [pleading]: "I've told you I'm in shock. "
- PC L: "If you don't move it I'll arrest you for public disorder, you'll offend people driving past who see it. "
- Mr Ronny Meah requests permission to pray and then prays in the Muslim Salat style (kneeling head on the ground). Both PCs stand over Mr Meah.
- PC L: Again persists in requests for "The dog to be moved"., Mr Ronny Meah tells him that his daughter needs to see it & be involved.
- Mr Ronny Meah explains the history between himself, Mr M Senior & Mr M Junior [see supplementary notes].
- PC L: agrees that the dog can stay for one hour.
- PC W requests a formal statement from Mr Ronny Meah, he agrees and begins to take statement.
- During taking the statement Mr M Junior arrives again & interrupts the process of taking statement.
- Mr Ronny Meah asks him to leave his property as he is giving a statement to the police.
- PC L walks towards Mr M Junior and states that he would be interviewed shortly.
- PC W offers witness protection. Mr Ronny Meah says he would like witness protection & PC W says he will get back to him.
- PC W completes taking the statement & Mr Ronny Meah reads statement.

- Mr Ronny Meah expresses his dissatisfaction with statement since it doesn't include details of the previous racist attacks made by Mr M Senior and Mr M Junior.
- Mr Ronny Meah attempts to add to the statement in his own writing & own words.
- PC W accuses Mr Ronny Meah of being awkward & says he will arrest him if he doesn't cooperate.
- Mr Ronny Meah calls over Y to act as an independent witness to the fact that PC W was interfering with the statement & threatening to arrest him.
- PC W and PC L state to Mr Ronny Meah that they are going to arrest Mr M Senior.
- Mr Ronny Meah asks if they are going to arrest him for attempted murder & arrest Mr M Junior for attempting to pervert the course of justice by claiming it was him driving.
- PC W says no he wont be arresting Mr M Senior for attempted murder & he cant interview Mr M Junior.
- Mr Ronny Meah is puzzled since earlier PC L had stated to Mr M Junior would be interviewed shortly.
- Both PCs leave presumably to arrest Mr M Senior although they don't state this.
- Mr Ronny Meah goes inside his property to compose himself.
- Around 30 minutes later PC W telephones Mr Ronny Meah and tells him that Mr M Senior is in custody and so drunk he cannot be interviewed. Mr Ronny Meah asks about witness protection and is informed that he (PC W) will get back to him.
