appeared original and untouched, I then looked at the stamped in chassis number, which I recorded as JAATFS16HK7100341 , again this appeared original and untouched. I made enquiries on the police national computer and found that these numbers were an exact match to a Bedford pick up F752 RVW which had been reported Stolen on the 24th August 1999.

On the 18th November 1999 at Brentwood police station I examined a Grey coloured Ford Transit van bearing the registration H269 CKX. I looked for the stamped in chassis number and found that it had been ground away and painted over with grey paint, I found that the stamped in engine number had also been erased by grinding. I looked for the VIN plate located on the passenger side step panel and saw that it was missing. I removed some of the paint from around the area where the stamped chassis number should have been and after working on this area I was able to establish that the original chassis number was SFALXXBDVLNC21175 and checks made on the police national computer showed this number to be an exact match to a Grey Ford Transit van K825 WOV that had been reported stolen on the 05th February 1999.
