ANSWERING A REPORT OF A SUSPECTED STOLEN VEHICLE AT ABOVE LOCATION (ANONYMOUS INFORMATION) PC CANNINGS AND DC BROWN ATTEND ABOVE LOCATION. THE PREMISES IS AN INDOOR TENNIS CENTRE SITUATED ALONGSIDE THE A127 SOUTHEMDS ARTERIAL ROAD. THE DEFENDANT'S FATHER OWNS THE SITE AND ALLOWS THE DEFENDANT TO USE THE SITE TO REPAIR MOTOR VEHICLES MAKING USE OF STORAGE UNITS AND WASTE GROUND SITE. I INSPECTED THE SITE AND SUBSEQUENTLY RECOVERED THE FOLLOWING VEHICLES WHICH HAD IDENTIFYING ???? REMOVED AND BEARING FALSE INDEX PLATES:

TUCKER ARRESTED SUS HANDLING OTHER GOODS IN RESPECT OF VEHICLE (1) ??? GODDARD OF ESSEX POLICE STOLEN VEHICLE UNIT HAD IDENTIFIED (2) - (4) INCLUSIVE.

18 SEARCH ON VEHICLE K82S WOV (H937 CKX) WHICH TUCKER STATED HE OWNED RESULTED IN A DIARY BEING SEIZED WHICH CONTAINED THE WORDS "CUT TRANSIT IN HALF"

SHORT DESCRIPTIVE NOTE OF INTERVIEW

DURING INTERVIEW TUCKER STATED THAT IN RESPECT OF VEHICLES (1), (3) AND (4) HE HAD STORED THEM AS A FAVOUR OR INDIVIDUALS WHOM HE INITIALLY DECLINED TO NAME FOR FEAR OF REPRISALS WHEN INTERVIEWED ON 15.11.99.

WHEN INTERVIEWED ON 02.02.2000 TUCKER ONE OF THE MALES WAS JOHN BUT DIDN'T KNOW HIS SURNAME. HE MAINTAINED HE HAD BEEN TAKEN ADVANTAGE OF BY THESE MALES AND KNOW OR BELIEVE ANY OF THE VEHICLES WERE STOLEN.

IN RESPECT OF VEHICLE (2) TUCKER STATED HE HAD PURCHASED THIS VEHICLE ON 15TH JUNE 1999 FROM A MALE NAMED LARRY FOR £1700.00 WHOM HE MET CASUALLY IN THE JET GARAGE ARDLEIGH GREEN ROAD A127 ARTERIAL ROAD AND DIDN'T BELIEVE THE VEHICLE WAS STOLEN OR KNOWN IT TO BE STOLEN.
